



Tips for Conserving Water this Summer

Seattle is currently in the "Advisory Stage" of its "Water Shortage Contingency Plan," due to historic low river levels and this summer's heat wave. This first phase of the plan asks Seattle residents to be mindful of their water usage. Here are some tips put together by the Saving Water Partnership, a group of local water utilities in Seattle and King County working together to help customers save water and money:

- Watering early or late: Water before 8 a.m. or after 7 p.m., which reduces evaporation.
- Watering deeply, but infrequently: It's better to have one or two deep waterings, rather than several shallow waterings.
- Fixing leaks: Fix obvious indoor and outdoor leaks such as at faucets, hose bibs and sprinkler spray heads. Check for less obvious leaks such as silent toilet leaks. Put several drops of food coloring in your toilet tank;
